Is there a convenient way to typeset the floor or ceiling of a number, without needing to separately code the left and right parts? For example, is there some way to do ...

When floor a number, you can think of it as replacing the Mantissa with $\$0\$$ $\$ \$\lfloor 2.31 \rfloor = 2 + 0 = 2\$$ and ceil can be thought of as replacing the mantissa with $\$1\$$. $\$ \$\lceil 2.31 \rceil = \dots$

I suspect that this question can be better articulated as: how can we compute the floor of a given number using real number field operations, rather than by exploiting the printed notation, ...

The height of the floor symbol is inconsistent, it is smaller when the fraction contains a lowercase letter in the numerator and larger when the fraction contains numbers or ...

The correct answer is it depends how you define floor and ceil. You could define as shown here the more common way with always rounding downward or upward on the number line.

The PGFmath package includes a ceil and a floor function. The pgfplots offers a few options for Constant Plots (see manual v1.8, subsection 4.4.3, pp. 57ff.). The option jump ...

What are some real life application of ceiling and floor functions? Googling this shows some trivial applications.

It natively accepts fractions such as $1000/333$ as input, and scientific notation such as $1.234e2$; if you need even more general input involving infix operations, there is the floor function ...
